



# CREATIVE PAINT

**Ready to use, coloured PVA glue used to make high-build, 3D-like pictures. Bright, glossy finish - wide range of colours - non toxic .**

*Five Star Creative Paint can also be used to make window stickers, leadlight effects, stone creatures and many other designs. Can be used on just about any surface and when dry can be peeled off shiny or non porous surfaces (eg plastic bag, foil, polythene, margarine or ice cream lid, acetate sheet or Five Star Paints Printing Foam).*



## BUTTERFLY SQUISHY MIRROR PICTURE

Great for the younger age group

### You will need:

- 1 Paper or thin card, pencil
- 2 Five Star Creative Paints

### Instructions:

- 1 Lightly fold the paper or card in half to get a centre line, open out flat again.
- 2 Lightly draw a pencil outline of half a butterfly on one side of the paper/card.
- 3 Squeeze the Five Star Creative Paint around the outline and then use other colours to add random dots, stripes or patterns. Be careful not to use too much paint.
- 4 Fold the paper in half, pressing gently and open it out again. You can add extra outlines to further define the wings and body if you like .

## FEATHERING

### You will need:

- 1 Card (or plastic if you want to peel it off later) and pencil.
- 2 Five Star Creative Paints
- 3 Bowl or circular object - needs to be the size of the outside ring of your pattern
- 4 Stylus or a toothpick

### Instructions:

- 1 Draw around the bowl to get a perfect circle.
- 2 Starting from the outside, squeeze a circle of Five Star Creative Paint in your chosen colour.
- 3 Using the other colours squeeze circles, alternating colours until finished in the centre.
- 4 Take the stylus/toothpick and drag from the centre to the outside in a straight line. Wipe clean the stylus/toothpick each time you drag.

**Hint: you can start from the centre of the circle, but you may find the circles become a bit wobbly as they get larger.**



## FISH

### You will need:

- 1 Five Star Creative Paints
- 2 Plastic, acetate sheet or similar so fish can be removed
- 3 Pen and paper



### Instructions:

- 1 On paper make an outline drawing of a fish. Lay the plastic/acetate sheet over your drawing and begin squeezing the Five Star Creative Paint around the outlines - black is good to use on outlines. Leave this to dry a little - approx 1 hour (it will take at least 24 hours to completely dry).
- 2 For the eyes - fill in the eye area with white and let it dry enough to form a skin, then squeeze a black dot for the eyeball.
- 3 Using other colours, squeeze into the areas to make a colourful fish - use stripes, spots or swirls.



**To make a scene of fish in the sea** - paint the sea background on a piece of card or paper using Five Star Paint dyes, washable or acrylic paints. On plastic or acetate sheet make your fish as per the instructions and let dry. Remove and arrange your fish on the sea background using a piece of Blue Tac to attach the fish. Change the scene round as often as you like and experiment making pieces of seaweed.

**Hint: to make your fish a window sticker, wipe the back with dishwashing liquid and push onto a window - it will stick for months."**
