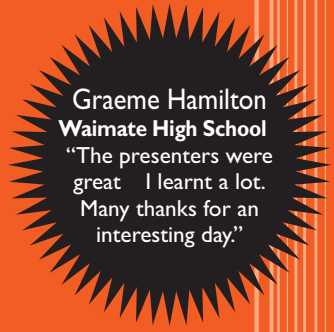

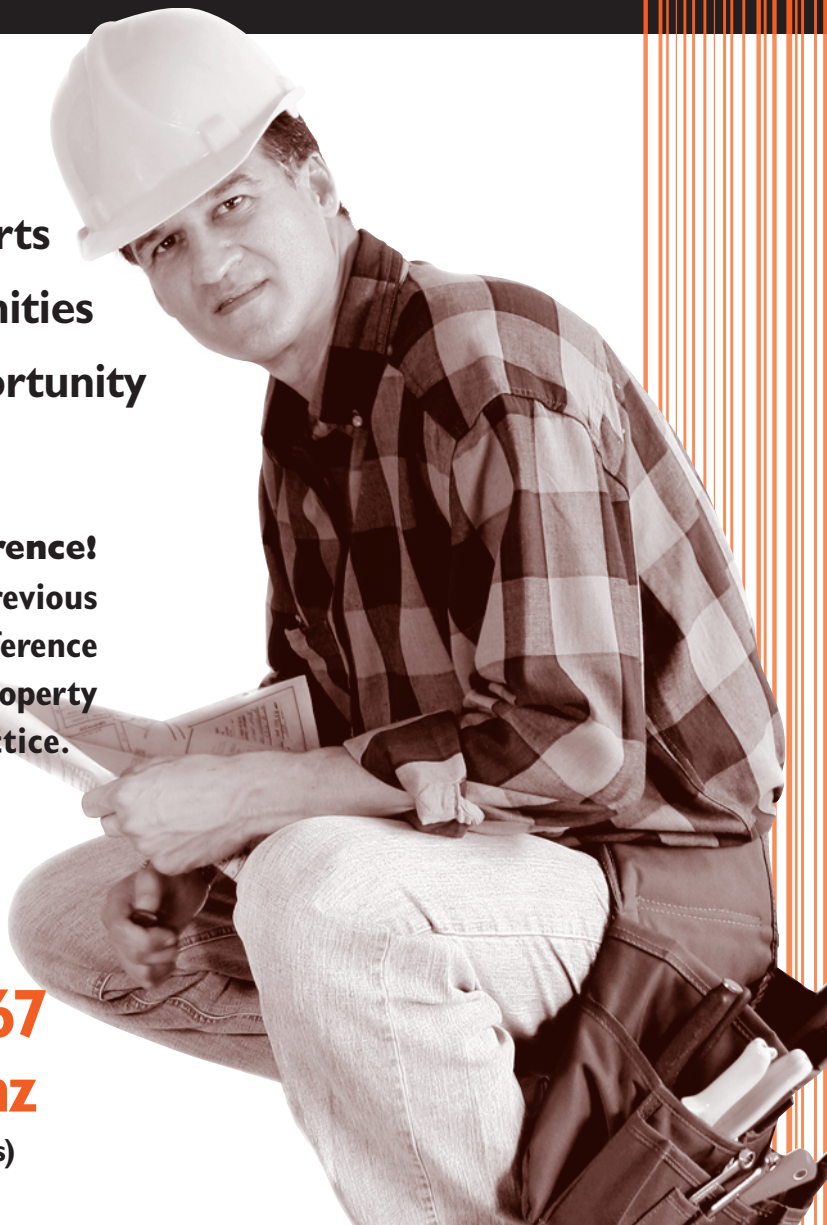

Clive also has a Degree in Engineering, a Master's Degree in Urban and Regional Planning and is a qualified Local Government Engineer.

### **Gareth Harper** **Wai-Ora Forest Landscapes**

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Wai Ora is a landscape contracting company and native plant nursery specialising in restoration, conservation and environmental care. Recent projects include the award winning Ocean Ridge subdivision and Kate Valley landfill; Anzac Drive Expressway; Clearwater Golf Resort; and Pegasus Town conservation areas. Their Environmental Care team also contributed and cared for over 300 specimens featured in the Supreme award winning exhibit at this year's Ellerslie International Flower Show. ### **Amit Raut** **Account Manager Christchurch, Initial Hygiene**

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Colds, flu and gastroenteritis can all be transferred from surfaces to staff members and pupils, leading to cross contamination throughout the school. Good hygienic practices begin at a primary stage. For the past two years, as part of New Zealand Foodsafe Week, Initial Hygiene have gone into schools and conducted hand hygiene programmes to educate young New Zealanders about the importance of hand hygiene – and the difference it can make to their health.

### **Rosita Guy** **Guy Associates**

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With her knowledge of people and workplace dynamics, Rosita has a firm belief in dealing with the cause, not the symptom. Her workshops enjoy a reputation of being entertaining and stimulating, delivered with a large dose of common sense and a dry sense of humour. Rosita makes her audiences question their personal behaviour by proposing that in order to change, one first needs to change oneself. She will show how replacing old, unsuccessful habits with new productive habits will bring positive results on many levels.

In this workshop, he will discuss the management of armed events in general and the principles of critical incident planning and response in relation to the unique school environment.

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Vertical Horizonz is a private training establishment focused on industry based training and assessment in disciplines associated with height safety, commercial road transport, professional development, health and safety training. Vertical Horizonz trainers are NZQA approved, accredited Workplace Assessors, and many hold a NZ Certificate in Adult Teaching.

### **Steve Gurney** **Triathlon Athlete, Teambuilding Coach**

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Steve, well known as that "Crazy Coast to Coast guy," has won the Coast to Coast 9 times in a row. 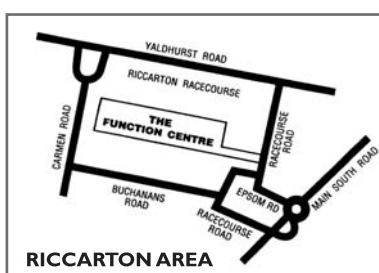
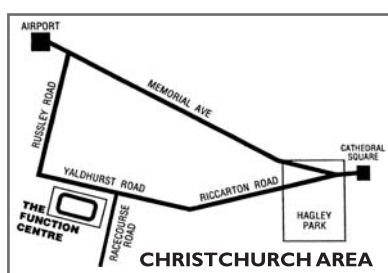
